A. Principal's Office

One such innovation is the SMART Board, an interactive whiteboard that responds to touch, enabling us to write and manipulate content. By utilizing this tool, we can actively involve students in the lessons, encouraging them to participate and take notes, ultimately fostering active learning. In 2022, the SMART Board was installed in our college. Starting from November 2022, French was introduced as a second language for all first-year students who expressed interest. These French classes were conducted online and proved to be successful, partly due to the utilization of the SMART Board.



Seminar Hall: *The seminar hall has a seating capacity of 500, equipped with a projector, microphone and speakers for presentations and a TV. It boasts excellent ventilation to ensure a comfortable and productive environment for large gatherings and events.*

Kitchen & Dining Hall

Our College has a spacious store area to preserve all the food items required for the preparation of meals. This area is carefully organized to maintain the freshness and quality of the ingredients.



*The store area is equipped with adequate shelves to store an extensive variety of food items. We ensure proper labelling and arrangement of perishable and non-perishable items, taking into consideration their shelf life, temperature requirements, and food safety guidelines. Adjacent to the store area is our fully-equipped kitchen, where all the cooking takes place. **Breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner are provided according to the menu chart prepared by Head Office.** The kitchen is meticulously maintained and regularly sanitized to ensure the highest food safety standards are met.*



Our dining area is specifically designed to accommodate up to 200 students at a time. The layout of the dining area ensures proper ventilation and ample space between tables, promoting a relaxed and pleasant atmosphere.

Sports Room

The sports room is fully equipped with a wide range of sports equipment and items, including badminton and cricket bats, balls, chess and carom boards, table tennis equipment, batting pads, gloves, bicycles, cricket wickets and stamps, cricket mats, wicket keeping pads, discus throw, football, and much more. Additionally, there are outdoor facilities for various sports and activities.

Special Gym for students

The gym, established in 2021, is equipped with a variety of fitness equipment and accessories. This includes Hex Head Bolts, GFID-31 (possibly a type of gym bench), quick-release ring pins, end caps, foot caps, nylon washers, foam rollers, and more. These items contribute to a well-rounded fitness facility for students and staff to stay active and healthy.



E. Wellness Centre

The Wellness Centre at our institution is a dedicated space where the health and well-being of our students are prioritized. Headed by a qualified staff nurse, the center provides immediate care to students who may be unwell. The nurse assesses the severity of the condition and, when necessary, refers students to the local Primary Health Care (PHC) doctor for further evaluation. This collaboration ensures that students receive prompt and appropriate medical attention. Additionally, the health status of students is monitored daily, with reports being closely observed by PANACEA and TSWREIS, reinforcing our commitment to maintaining a healthy and supportive environment for our student community.



K. Dormitories
